

Developed India Resolution Journey

The Prime Minister launched the "Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra" on 15th November 2023, on the birth anniversary of Lord Birsa Munda, which became a symbol of public participation within a few days. 






This is the 'Flight' of the common man

Today, there are more than 149 operational airports for aviation in the country, which include 30 international airports, 12 customs airports, 107 domestic airports, and a few air enclaves inside military airports. There are further plans to build more airports: 6 more by 2030, 15 more by 2040, and 30 more by 2047.

Bullet Train



New Bharat's Train Vande-Bharat

The 'Vande Bharat' train is also called the train of modern India. This world-class passenger train has facilities like onboard infotainment, GPS, CCTV cameras, sliding doors, fire sensors, and bio-toilets. This train is completely indigenous. Travel time on this train is much less compared to Shatabdi trains. India's first Vande Bharat train ran between Varanasi and Delhi on 18 February 2019. Today the network of Vande Bharat trains is developing all over India. This train is an important part of India's Make-in-India plan. This train is being manufactured at the Integral Coach Factory of Indian Railways located in Chennai. It costs around INR 100 crore to make a Vande Bharat train. The speed of this train is now being increased from 160 KMPH to 200 KMPH. There is a plan to operate Vande Bharat trains at 100 places across India during the golden period of independence.





The first train in India ran from Bori Bunder railway station to Thane in 1853. This train was operated by the Great Indian Peninsular Railways. After this, only 'Victoria Terminus' was built in Mumbai in 1888, which is now renamed as 'Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus'. Today Indian Railways is moving towards a modern era. Now, 13,523 trains run daily in the country. Railways has 300 railway yards, 2,300 goods yards, and 700 train repair factories. Today, Railways is converting its engines from steam/diesel engines to electric locomotives. Indian Railways today operate passenger and goods trains in 16 zones. Railways have an important place in boosting the economy of the country. The Railways has its own locomotives, carriage wagons, bridge factories and signal factories. Indian Railways was nationalised in 1950. The Railway Board was established in March 1905 before independence. In 1986, Indian Railways developed its own computerised reservation system.

To Convert Artisans into Businessmen





In ancient times, the basis of India's economy depended on these artisans. After independence, this is the first such scheme for the upliftment of the artisan brothers, which will help in giving recognition to the artisan brothers across the country at the global level. It is the vision of Prime Minister that every skilled artisan and craftsman of the country should get the benefit of this scheme.





On September 20, the Narendra Modi government passed the Nari Shakti Vandan Act with majority in the Lok Sabha after a long debate. On September 21, this bill was also passed in the Rajya Sabha. After the signature of President Daupadi Murmu, the Women's Reservation Bill, which increases women's participation in parliamentary proceedings, has now become law. Now 33 percent of seats have been reserved for women in all the Legislative Assemblies and Lok Sabha of the country. At present, women will get reservation only for 15 years to become MPs and MLAs. After 15 years, to maintain women's reservation, this law will have to be approved again by the Parliament. Nari Shakti Vandan Act will not be implemented in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections because the census is necessary for the format and process of this bill. After the new census data comes out, the Election Commission will delimit the assembly and Lok Sabha seats for Women's afresh.


Act-East Policy

Citizenship Amendment Act










Judicial System








Unparalleled Parliamentary Work






Pradhan Mantri Shramyogi Maandhan Yojana

"Pradhan Mantri Shram Yogi Maandhan Yojana," was implemented nationwide on 15 February 2019, now its benefits have been extended to workers in the unorganized sectors, including vegetable sellers, tea vendors, drivers, rickshaw pullers, cobblers, tailors, labourers, domestic workers, kiln workers, and daily wage labourers. This scheme ensures that beneficiaries receive a monthly pension of up to Rs 3,000/- after reaching the age of 60. Eligibility for this scheme is limited to individuals aged 18 to 40, who contribute Rs. 55/- monthly. Notably, income tax payers are ineligible to avail themselves of this program.





Farmers get money in installments of Rupees two thousand each and eligibility is decided considering the area of land, source of income and some other parameters. Apart from this, about 3 crore farmers have also been given the benefit of a 3-month moratorium on loans.

According to Union Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare Minister, Shri Narendra Singh Tomar, a total of 201 suggestions were received from the Swaminathan Commission for improving the condition of farmers in the country, of which 200 suggestions have been diligently implemented by Honourable Prime Minister Modi, with the crucial implementation of the recommendations that farmers receive one and a half times the price of their production costs. 








Freedom of the Press (Press Council)






Zero tolerance for corruption
